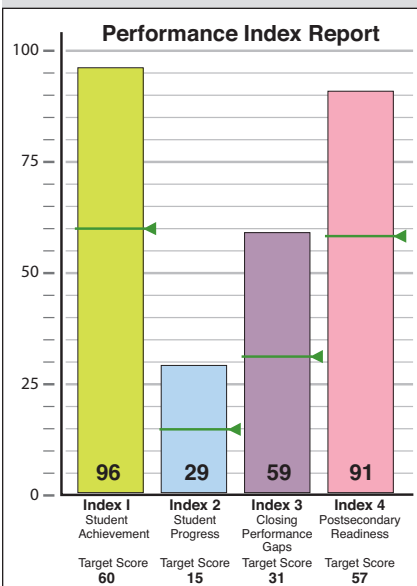
Campus programs:
